The attributes of a fine German *Riesling* are many - long known for its spectacular food pairing qualities, age ability, and sensuality. At the top tier of classified German *Riesling* exists the term *Crosses Gewachs* simply labeled as "GG". *Crosses Gewachs Riesling* represents a producer's top wine sourced from what is lawfully defined as a Grand Cru vineyard. When you strive to drink the best German *Riesling* on the planet look no further than "GG". No other dry white wine seduces and overwhelms the senses with such charm and class. Alluring, persuasive aromatics promising a hedonistic fruit set with volumes of extract contained within a chiseled physique. These wines are of such splendor that modern vocabulary can't adequately describe them. Pop one open, decant, and let their wares tell the story.

PIEMONTE

Piedmont, the home of white truffles, vermouth, and the House of Savoy, is second only to Tuscany in the renown of its red wines. Piedmont, literally meaning “foot of the mountain”, is bordered to the North by the Swiss Alps, and it is in the foothills of the Alps that the best wine is produced. Nebbiolo is the king of grape varieties here. Early to blossom and late to ripen, the grape produces the massively complex and quixotically elegant wines known as Barolo and Barbaresco, which are both produced by law with 100% Nebbiolo. These wines can age for decades as their massive tannins settle. Piedmont is also home to Barbera and Dolcetto, more youthful and fruit forward wines produced from their native namesake varietals. Yet when they are planted in the right vineyard sites alongside Nebbiolo, they often produce richly complex wines.

| BARBERA, DOLCETTO, AND OTHER NOTABLE WINES |

As in the rest of Italy, Piedmont is home to indigenous varietals, all with eminently drinkable character. Barbera and Dolcetto are Piedmontese neighbors of Nebbiolo. What they lack in austerity and tannic might, they make up for with rich fruit profiles and healthy acidity, which makes these varietal wines fantastic food companions. With the right conditions, these wines can sometimes age for a decade or more. Dolcetto exudes lean notes of wild bramble berries and black tea with bright fruit driven acidity. Barbera is the rounder, more fruit forward of these two varietals, and one of our favorite food wines. Barolo and Barbaresco lovers can also find awesome wines from neighboring DOC's.

PIEMONTE | | BARBARESCO: THE QUEEN |

Italy's answer to Burgundy lies in the Nebbiolo-producing villages of Piedmont. Made with solely Neb- biolo grapes, this is tne more graceful brother of the wines produced in the neigh- boring Barolo region. Although Barbaresco shares similarities with Barolo, it is considered the more elegant and approachable of the two noble reds of Piedmont. It is little more than 10km from the village of Barolo, but Barbaresco hugs the river Tenaro a bit more tightly (which of- fers a moderating effect on climate) and vineyard sites tend to be slightly less steep and lower altitude. Barbaresco shares the translucent brick red coloring of its neighbor, Barolo, along with a nose of tar, rose petals, and white truffles on a loamy forest floor. Rich flavors of raspber- ry, cherry, licorice, and fennel on the palate.

“The Wine of Kings and the King of Wines.” this standard bearer of Italian vino is produced in an area encircling the village of Barolo. Barolo is generally considered more austere and “masculine” than its Barbaresco counterpart, and is also made with 100% Nebbiolo grapes. By law, Barolo is aged in oak for a minimum of three years before release, with the “Riserva” designation being given at five years. Barolo is a powerhouse wine, possessing the tannic structure and acidic balance to age for decades. It is recognized for its aromatic bouquet of tar and roses, brick red translucent appearance despite its full body, and rich flavors of raspberry, chocolate, and violets. Smokey notes of fennel, white truffles, and star anise abound. Burgundy, meet your match.

| VENETO: IN VERONA WHERE WE LAY OUR SCENE |

Veneto, located in the Northwest of Italy, is the home of some of Italy's greatest red wines, and is most commonly recognized as the home of Prosecco, Italy's most renowned sparkling wine. It often tops the list as Italy's largest wine producing region. Despite the volume of their production, world famous wines adored by many a wine aficionado and sommelier can be found in Veneto. Amarone della Valpolicella DOCG, one of the richest, statuesque, and complex wines in the world, has been crafted for centuries by hand-harvesting and drying the grapes for months to concentrate the flavors before fermentation, known as the *appassimento* process. It is amongst Italy's biggest and boldest red wines, with opulent, densely packed flavors of cherry, plum, raisin, and spice that are capable of decades of aging, which produces unmatched depth. Amarone's baby brother, Valpolicella *Ripasso*, is made with the same grapes as Amarone (Corvina, Rondinella, and Molinara), but represents a great value at a much lower price. The juice of Valpolicella *Ripasso* (meaning "re-passed") goes through a second fermentation over the skins, seeds, and the other delicious bits remaining from the Amarone process, adding complexity and depth.

| BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO |

Brunello di Montalcino holds the throne of Italian wine. Brunello is a wine of broad structure, with great concentration, suppleness, longevity, and above all else, power. For centuries, Chianti remained the most prolific and renowned wine of Tuscany and even Italy as a whole, but this has changed. It was much more recently that Brunello di Montalcino burst onto the scene when one of its best producers released two vintages for tasting from the 1890s, both of which showed tremendous shape and excellent quality after having undergone the greater part of a century aging in their cellars. Brunello di Montalcino comes from a specific clone, or strain, of Sangiovese (the grape of Chianti). This clone is known as Brunello, or Sangiovese Grosso. These are wines that need the greater part of a decade or more before they shed their youthfulness and harmonize their flavors. However, some winemakers such as Argiano and Carmigliano are producing more modern Brunellos fit for earlier consumption.

Chianti has taken its place as the most recognizable Italian wine. Historically encased in straw-covered flasks, these cheap versions can be found peppering the red and white checkered tablecloths of Italian restaurants worldwide. Despite appearances, Chianti that is produced in the heart of the Chianti region, is labeled Chianti Classico and the Riserva designation is for those wines that have been aged in oak for at least three years. While Chianti's vary tremendously in style, they all tend to share an earthy bright cherry bouquet, floral notes, spices, and food-friendly acidity.

| BOLGHERI & THE SUPER TUSCANS |

The Super Tuscan wave began in the 1970's after a small group of Tuscan winemakers became frustrated with the DOC and DOCG laws created in 1963, which strictly regulated how they make their wines. These producers began crafting high quality avant-garde wines under the less prestigious *Vino da Tavola* designation that garnered immense international praise. In order to distinguish their wines within the *Vino da Tavola* category they coined the term Super Tuscan wines. The *Indicazione Geografica Tipica* (IGT) appellation was created to indicate that these wines are of higher quality than table wine, but do not meet DOC or DOCG regulations for their region. These wines often include international varietals and tend to be rich, are-worthy, and expensive. Classic examples are Sassicaia, recognition for its excellence and historic importance, Tenuta San Guido and its Sassicaia wine were awarded their own monopole, Bolgheri Sassicaia DOC.

| THE LESSER KNOWN NOBILITY OF TUSCANY |

Once reserved for the nobility of Montepulciano, a quaint hilltop village in Southern Tuscany, these robust dry red wines rival Chianti's and Brunello's hierarchical status. It is a historical wine made from the same clonal varietal as Brunello di Montalcino, Sangiovese Grosso, but known locally around Montepulciano as Prugnolo Gentile. These wines are a fantastic compromise between Chianti Classico and Brunello di Montalcino. They often have more substance than Chianti Classico, and also avoid the austerity and tannic structure of Brunello di Montalcino.

UMBRIA

Umbria is a region that has long been overshadowed by its western neighbor, Tuscany, in the international wine scene. Its most popular wine is a white wine, Orvieto DOC, which usually accounts for 75% of its wine production, but there are several red wines with growing international infamy that pack complex, hearty fruit and spice flavors. Legend tells that Saint Francis of Assisi brought back a cutting of a vine from the Middle East, and this wine was cultivated into the Sagrantino di Montefalco DOCG today. These are massively tannic wines (some of the most tannic in the world) with complex earthy flavors marked by dark red fruit, spice, and smoke that will age for 10, 15, or even 20 years in great vintages.

Campania, another one of Italy's oldest winemaking regions, produces exotic wines from native grape varietals, such as Greco di Tufo, Fiano, and Aglianico, the great red varietal of the region (and a grape that is certainly in the running for the most noble grape of Italy). The richly complex wines of the region derive their personalities from the volcanic soils surrounding Mount Vesuvius. In particular, the Taurasi DOCG, made from Aglianico grapes, is known for the sweet smoky, earth character imparted by the volcanic soil and is sometimes described as the "Barolo of the South".

| SARDEGNA: A SPAGHETTI WESTERN |

The island of the Sardinia offers wines of unique character. Having been removed from the mainland Italy both geographically and culturally for much of its history, the mid-Mediterranean island produces wines with both Italian and Spanish traditions. The Spanish/Italian connection is best represented by Isola dei Nuraghi IGT Argiolas Turriga, a collector's wine made with Cannonau (Sardinia's name for Grenache) and crafted by the same oenologist who consulted on Sassicaia. The region's rising star, the Alghero DOC, is represented below by Sella & Mosca *Marchese di Villamarina*, the winner of the Tre Bicchieri award, Italy's highest wine honor, a dozen times in the past two decades.
